Rep Training Report by Julie Atkinson

On October 29th & 30th, I went along to Stow College, Glasgow along with Matt Armes, Marion Smith and Andy Eaglesham to the "Supporting and Mentoring Learners" course. This course was run by the Communication Workers Union. The course aims were to help us provide active support for learners, set up study groups for learners, respond to learners' needs and motivate and engage learners. We worked together as a group on the first day, but the second day we were split up to work with people from other companies. This was beneficial as there were a lot of practical tasks each day, so it was helpful to learn what Unionlearn reps elsewhere do to support their learners. Each activity was very focused and the trainers helped keep discussions going by questioning our responses. We considered everything from different methods of helping people understand information and which are appropriate in certain circumstances to setting up and running study sessions. Hopefully we will get to use our newly learned skills in our Unionlearn work by supporting Aegon learners soon.
